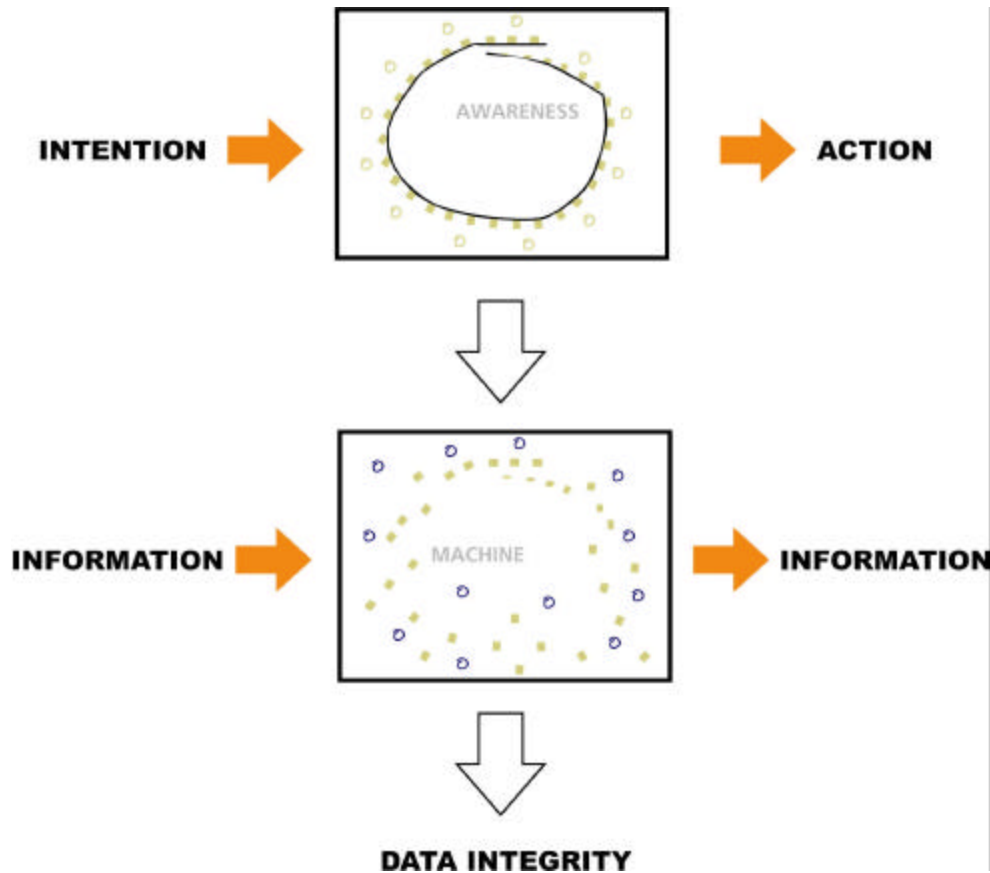


Divergent Concept
